The use of PDT is now routine in most dermatologists' offices. PDT has been used successfully for non-melanoma skin cancers and actinic keratoses. Many clinicians have shown that using PDT, with both blue and red light, and a variety of photosensitizers, is successful for the treatment of moderate to severe acne. This presentation will review the clinical studies that support this claim and to show how best to use this modality in one's clinical practice.
