## OBJECTIVE EVALUATION OF THE IMPROVEMENT IN SKIN HYPERPIGMNTATION USING A COMBINED PROTOCOL OF CHEMICAL PEELING AND TOPIC CREAM

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In the personal experience we used a combined protocol for treatment of the hyperpigmentation of the face planned with a chemical peeling (salicilic acid, piruvic acid and retinoic acid) associated with a treatment with a topic cream (kojic acid 0,3 %, vitamin A and E, Aquaxyl complex 3%). The methods included one chemical peeling followed by a 30 days treatment with the cream. The efficacy of the treatment was evaluated under the subjective poit of view (Likert scale) and under the objective point of view with the evaluation of images with DACS (Digital Analysis of Cutaneous Surface). The primary endpoint was the objective evaluation of the improvement in the reduction of hyperpigmentation, the second endpoint was the evaluation in the improvement in the skin texture.



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
