## EXERESIS OF SUBUNGUAL MELANOMA AND RECONSTRUCTION WITH CROSS-HYPOTHENAR FLAP

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We present the case of a woman diagnosed with subungual melanoma in situ of the IV finger of the left hand.

Resection of the entire nail apparatus of the distal phalanx with a supra-periosteum depth was performed saving the fingertip. Then the reconstruction was made using a cross-hypothenar flap and a partial thickness skin graft. Furthermore a Zimmer splint was used in order to avoid potential harmful movements.
