CUTANEOUS TUBERCULOSIS STUDY CASE

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Background: M.H 15 year old Female Sweda Syria

The complain began seven years ago with chronic ulcers with facial erythma and upper lipenlargement.

Observation: A well demarcated, slightly elevated infiltrated plaque with scarring in the center

The case has increased until total tissues loss [Pick Nose]

Oral, Nasal mucosae are involved small, soft gray, ulcers, pink papules bleed easily.

Pressure with a glass slide shows small yellowish-brown spots. Apple-jelly.

Enlargement region lymph nodes.

The diagnosed was cutaneous Leishmaniasis positive test.

The patient had been treated with glucantim for one year no improvement has been occurred.

Key message: The patient had been treated with anti-tuberculosis drugs with good results.

Biopsy: lupus vulgaris

Results: Plastic surgery has been made after one year with good result.

Conclusions: Lupus vulgaris
