## NEVOID HYPERKERATOSIS OF THE NIPPLE-AREOLAR COMPLEX- WHAT WE KNOW AND DON'T KNOW!

Nevoid hyperkeratosis is a rare and benign skin disease affecting the nipple-areolar complex in females of child bearing age. Eruption of unsightly lesions is very distressing to the patient, hence effective treatment with an acceptable outcome is necessary. We report a case of a 38 year old female patient with complains of a rash on her nipples and areola since approximately 3years. It was initially very small in size but increased to involve about three-fourths of the areolae. We report this case to delve into the etiology and discuss various treatment options and outcomes.
