



SKIN CANCER (OTHER THAN MELANOMA)

MY EXPERIENCE WITH INGENOL MEBUTATE IN CLINIC AND HISTOLOGICAL ANATOMY

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BACKGROUND: Four patients with actinic keratosis and field cancerization present themselves. The only treatment they underwent was ingenol mebutate. Before and after this treatment histopathological studies were carried out.

OBSERVATION: It was confirmed in a case in which the actinic keratosis had a severe dysplasia, and after the ingenol mebutate treatment, a histopathological study confirmed the dysplasia was slight. Moreover, all patients clinically improved and did not suffer from atrophy.

KEY MESSAGE: Ingenol mebutate topical treatment, clinical improvement, histological change with a decrease in the degree of dysplasia in actinic keratosis.
