

SKIN CANCER (OTHER THAN MELANOMA)

VULVAR SYRINGOMA COMBINED WITH MILIA

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Background: Syringoma is a benign adnexal tumor, which usually occurs on the periorbital area of middle-aged women. Syringoma of the vulva has been rarely reported.

Observation: A 25 years old girl presented with multiple rice-sized papules on her vulva for more than 2 years. Skin examination showed numerous whitish, skin-coloured and brownish firm papules with the size of the rice to the mung bean. The papules distributed densely over her labia majora. And the lesions were very tough. The results of the histopathology are in accordance with vulvar syringoma combining with milia. Separated treatments by using Nd: YAG laser are effective.

Key messsage: we report a case of vulvar syringoma combined with milia.Nd:YAG laser is effective for syringoma of vulva combined with milia.
