## ATYPICAL MYCOBACTERIAL INFECTIONS IN MEXICO.

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These cutaneous infections are usually due to trauma, surgery or cosmetic procedures. Clinical features are: pustules, abscess, ulcers, panniculitis or nodular lesions. Presence of AFB is confirmed by Ziehl-Neelsn or Kinyoun stains, histopathology, culture or molecular biology.

In Mexico we have studied lymphadenitis, Buruli ulcer, abscess due to mycobacteria, swimming pool granuloma due to Mycobacterium marinum, mycobacterial infections in AID due to mycobacterium avim-intracelullare, nosocomial epidemic due to postsurgical procedures, cases due to mesotherapy, liposuction, tattoos and acupuncture. By PC we have isolatedM. absessus 10, M. masiliense 9, M. fortuitum 8, M. chelonae 4, M. mageritense, M. flavesens 2, M. marsellense, M. vulneris, M. kansasii, M. marinum, M. fuerth 1.

Mycobacterial infection are common in Mexico and all clinical forms have been observed.
