DAILY FACIAL DERMATOLOGICAL EMERGENCIES IN LARACHE.

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Introduction and objective. Facial dermatological emergencies are quite common and are dominated by infectious ones that can be life-threatening.

Our goal is to help young practitioner to recognize these emergencies and to classify them as extreme emergencies to hospitalize or in a delayed emergency to be treated in ambulatory.

Materials and methods. In dermatology consultation, the analysis of the cutaneous elementary lesion, the associated general signs, the patient's defects, the local and general treatments already received are the key for management.

Our clinical cases are then divided into three groups, two groups are emergencies while the third is not.

Results. Within the group facial dermatological emergencies, two groups are distinguished, the first is a real emergency that must be treated in hospital for vital or epidemiological or social reasons, while the second can be treated or assessed as outpatient and is hospitalized only if a complication is triggered.

Conclusion. Despite the performance of biological assessments, radiological progress, histological ... the dermatologist is endowed with an inexhaustible weapon: the critical clinical sense of lesion accessible to all, it is essential to preserve this particularity which is the eye of the dermatologist in a dermatology in full evolution and perpetual change.



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
